Wizards of the gaming world to do battle at the Brisbane Showgrounds

More than 3,000 gamers and hobby enthusiasts are expected to conquer the GhMX Gaming, Hobby and Model Expo at the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend.

The two-day event in the Exhibition Building on Saturday and Sunday will feature gaming tournaments including Pokémon, Minecraft and Halo 2, creative workshops, LEGO building, retailers and more.

A highlight will be the Dungeons and Dragons arena, with live demo matches complete with dungeon masters. The arena will include 10 tables of different terrain and custom campaigns, all interlinked with an overarching story.

The event has also introduced Australia's first resin 3D printing competition this year, calling on experienced model-makers to push the limits of 3D printing.

Comic book artists and illustrators Adam and Wayne Nichols are sure to be popular at the all-ages event, signing autographs and taking to the stage on Sunday to discuss creating comic and gaming worlds.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said it was their second consecutive year hosting the event.

"We're thrilled to welcome back Australia's newest event dedicated to gaming, hobbies and model building after hosting their inaugural expo in 2023," Mr Coyle said.

"The event really does offer all your gaming and hobby needs under the one roof and we're looking forward to seeing the popular expo continue to go from strength to strength."
