Lego expo stacks up as Queensland's largest

Thousands of LEGO enthusiasts will snap to it and flock to the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend for the much-anticipated BrisBricks LEGO Fan Expo.

Almost 10,000 people are expected to browse the brick-tacula displays by 150 local and interstate exhibitors in the Exhibition Building over two days (Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 September).

Queensland's largest LEGO fan expo will feature a 21 metre realms collaboration, huge train display with moving locomotives, great ball contraption module, exclusive VIP workshops, costumed characters, retail, plus food and drink.

There is also a new lights out experience on Saturday from 3.30-4.30pm, allowing visitors to fully appreciate the creative lighting effects on the stunning displays.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said it was their third year hosting the popular expo.

"Our staff really enjoy hosting this family-friendly event each year and welcoming LEGO fans and exhibitors from across the country," Mr Coyle said.

"We've seen our versatile Exhibition Building transformed by many event themes but a LEGO wonderland has to be one of our favourites."
