The Affordable Art Fair will be open to the public from Friday 9 May – Sunday 11 May and will host 50+ galleries from Australia and beyond, with 1,000 artworks on show.

From sculptures, murals, child-friendly workshops and interactive installations to sourcing that perfect piece of art for your home, or spoiling mum on Mother's Day, the Affordable Art Fair will offer a world of creativity.
